

Thank you for choosing our company to install your landscaping! We hope you enjoy your outdoor environment for years to come. Please contact us with any questions. Here are some guidelines to help you care for your landscaping.

IRRIGATION TIMER: Your irrigation system was installed with a landscape timer box. It is important to understand how to operate your timer box and to check it regularly to make sure it is operating properly. Your timer box will be set at the time of install to the proper settings for the current season. The homeowner will need to adjust the timer settings as the seasons change to water plants and trees properly for the current season. The times and durations necessary for your yard will depend on your plants, how much sun/shade your yard gets and the condition of your soil. You will be given a manual for your timer box.

SUGGESTED WATERING GUIDELINES: Here are some general guidelines to give you an idea of how to set your timer box. These guidelines will change for each yard depending on which plants you have, how much sun/shade you receive, the condition of your soil and the outdoor temperatures. These guidelines are for winter or summer...for the months in between you will need to find a happy medium that works for your plants. Keep an eye on your plants, feel the soil near the roots of your plants and adjust your timer box accordingly.

SUMMER:

PLANTS:	: Every Day, Twice Per Day, For 30 minutes each time.	
	Spread the two times out in 12 hour durations. For example: 6am and 6pm	
TREES:	One Day On, Two Days Off, For 30-35 minutes	

WINTER:

PLANTS:	Every Other Day, For 10-15 minutes
TREES:	One Day On, Two Days Off, For 30-35 minutes

PLANTS & TREES: Your plants and trees are covered under a 90 day warranty. Any plant or tree that we purchase and install in your yard that dies within 90 days will be replaced with a new plant/tree. Plants or trees that die from frost damage are not covered under warranty.

CACTUS & AGAVE: Cactus and agave (including Saguaro and Ocotillo) are not covered under warranty. Cactus and agave are not connected to your drip system unless a separate cactus irrigation zone was purchased as an upgrade to your landscaping. When not connected to a separate cactus irrigation zone, the homeowner needs to hand water the cactus. Hand water lightly with a hose long enough to reach the roots of the plant. Here is a suggested guideline for hand watering cactus: (this guideline will vary depending on how much sun/shade your cactus is getting and the condition of your soil)

SUMMER:Once or Twice Per WeekWINTER:Once every 2 or 3 weeks

IRRIGATION SYSTEM: Your irrigation system is covered under a 1 Year warranty.
